

Interession 2010 Information

Interession is a 10-day intensive session offering an opportunity for students to attend college level courses during the winter holidays.

1. Students are expected to complete the same amount of college work in 10 days as normally completed in a 15-week semester.
 2. Students are expected to attend every scheduled class meeting.
 3. Online students are expected to be online every day for 5 to 8 hours per day, per course.
 4. There are no snow make-up days. In case of inclement weather, faculty may provide students with a take-home assignment in advance, or post material to either the Portal or WebCT.
 5. Most classes meet Monday through Friday from 9:00 a.m.– 1:00 p.m. All classes are three credits each unless otherwise noted.
 6. Interession course enrollment is capped at 25. There will be no course over-rides for interession classes.
 7. There will be a faculty focus group convened in the spring semester to discuss this endeavor.
