CPT Testing:

As part of the program, you will take the College Placement Test (CPT) in the beginning and end of the program.

College ID's and Bus passes:

After you have completed your CPT test, you will be given a photo HCC I.D. and a bus pass. The HCC I.D. will provide you access to the campus facilities such as the Athletic and Recreation Center and the college library.

Travel Reimbursement and Attendance Incentive Awards:

Bus or car travel reimbursement will be available to all students – up to \$5/per night.

Attendance incentive awards will be given for each MCAS and work readiness class you attend – up to a \$5/per night gift certificate for the Holyoke Mall.

Both the travel reimbursement check and the attendance gift certificate will be given on the last night of class.
