# The Graduate Follow-up Survey CLASS OF 2022





# **Purpose of the Graduate Follow-up Survey**

Each year, Holyoke Community College (HCC) gathers information on our recent graduates. A graduate follow-up survey was distributed to all graduates from the current calendar year. The purpose of the graduate follow-up survey is two fold. First, students were asked to self-report on their employment and educational status. Second, it was an attempt to learn something about how HCC students evaluate the college and the experience(s) the college affords. Was their experience satisfying? Did it help them move toward their goals?

A survey for the class of 2022 was distributed to 632 graduates and 13% of these graduates responded to the survey. The graduate follow-up survey is administered 3-6 months after graduation. Survey data are based on graduates within a calendar year. Federal (IPEDS) and State (HEIRS) reports are based on fiscal year. As a result figures here may differ from those reported elsewhere.
