

Sen. Warren will host town hall meeting in Holyoke on Sunday

HOLYOKE — Holyoke Community College will welcome U.S. Sen. Elizabeth Warren (D-Cambridge) to campus for a town hall-style meeting tomorrow. All are invited.

Warren will talk about current issues and answer questions from the audience from 1-2 p.m. in the HCC Courtyard, on the campus at 303 Homestead Ave., Holyoke. In the event of inclement weather, the event will move indoors at the HCC Campus Center. Doors open at noon.

According to a statement from Warren's office, the senator is expected to answer questions, give updates on what she's fighting for in Washington, and discuss the most pressing issues facing Massachusetts and the nation.
