# TRANSFER ARTICULATION AGREEMENT BETWEEN Holyoke Community College and

Colby-Sawyer College

Colby-Sawyer College (CSC) and Holyoke Community College (HCC) support the joint goal to work collaboratively to assist students to pursue their online Registered Nurse (RN) to Bachelor of Science in Nursing degree. Therefore, CSC hereby agrees to offer admission to graduates of HCC who have completed the requirements for an Associate Degree in Nursing with:

- a cumulative grade point average of at least 2.0 on a four-point scale, and
- a minimum of sixty earned credits (only those courses with a grade of "C" or better will be eligible to transfer in), and
- · an active nursing license

#### A. Transfer Pathway:

Completion of the associate degree from HCC will satisfy most of the nursing program requirements at CSC. Equivalent courses taken at HCC will satisfy the parallel requirements at CSC, as per the transfer pathways agreed (Appendix 1) upon by CSC and HCC.

The minimum number of total credits required for baccalaureate graduation at CSC is 120 credits. The minimum number of credits that must be taken at CSC for baccalaureate graduation is 30 credits. All degree requirements must be satisfied in order to receive a degree from CSC, as detailed in the *College Catalog*.

Any student who wishes to transfer under the terms of this agreement must provide CSC with a current official transcript of academic work from HCC or any other college/university where coursework was completed.

#### B. Conditional Admission:

Students who are in their final semester (minimum 45 credits) and meet the grade point average of 2.0 would be a conditional admit to the program, pending submission Associate Degree transcripts and active nursing license.

#### C. Tuition Costs:

Students who are accepted to CSC under the terms of this agreement are eligible for a preferred tuition of \$270/credit plus \$10/credit online course fee.

### D. Financial Aid Opportunities:

Students who are accepted to CSC under the terms of this agreement are eligible for financial aid. Other financial aid opportunities, both federal and institutional, may be available. The CSC Admissions Office can provide additional information.
