Transfer Agreement between **Curry College Division of Continuing & Graduate Studies** and Holyoke Community College

Associate in Science Degree in Nursing **Bachelor of Science in Nursing**

This Agreement between Holyoke Community College and Curry College guarantees Holyoke graduates with an Associate Degree in Nursing and a current non-restricted Massachusetts nursing license acceptance into Curry College's Baccalaureate Degree with a major in Nursing offered through its Division of Continuing Education and guarantees the acceptance of all credits awarded in fulfillment of Holyoke Community College's Associate Degree requirements in Nursing.

This Agreement is designed to serve Nursing graduates from Holyoke Community College who seek to complete their Bachelor of Science degree with a major in Nursing through Curry College's Division of Continuing Education. This Agreement applies to students who enroll through Curry College's Division of Continuing and Graduate Studies.

Under this Agreement, Holyoke Community College graduates can transfer all credits earned in their Associate Degree and are waived from completing the General Education requirements at Curry College. Additional credits beyond the Associate Degree may also transfer into Curry. These additional credits will follow Curry's transfer credit policies. In total, 90 of the minimum 120 credits required to earn a Curry College degree may transfer. To support a seamless transition into the designated major, Curry's Continuing Education advisors will provide academic advising services to prospective Holyoke Community College students regarding degree completion requirements.

In addition, Holyoke Community College students who earn an Associate Degree from an academic area of study will be eligible for Curry's Education Partner Pricing*** through the Division of Continuing and Graduate Studies, which offers Holyoke Community College graduates a reduced percredit tuition rate.

Lastly, Holyoke Community College will provide opportunities for representatives of Curry College to visit Holyoke Community College locations and disseminate information about Curry College programs and this Agreement.

This Agreement is effective on the date signed and will remain in effect until either party terminates said Agreement.
