Free COVID testing resumes today at HCC

HOLYOKE — Starting today, April 27, COVID-19 testing will resume at Holyoke Community College.

HCC is partnering with Curative and the Holyoke Board of Health to offer free PCR tests seven days a week through Curative's mobile COVID-19 testing trailer.

The Curative trailer was previously stationed at the Holyoke Mall at Ingleside.

Testing is available weekdays, 10 a.m. to 5 p.m., and Saturdays and Sundays, 10 a.m. to 2 p.m., in Parking Lot M outside the Bartley Center for Athletics and Recreation on the main HCC campus at 303 Homestead Ave., Holyoke.

Testing hours are subject to change due to inclement weather or holidays.

State-sponsored Stop the Spread testing at HCC ended on March 31. Before that, HCC had been a COVID-19 testing site since the summer of 2020.

Curative uses self-collected, shallow nasal PCR tests. Results are generally available in 1-2 days.

Testing is free.

Walk-ins are welcome, though appointments are preferred.
