
Free computer literacy training offered

HOLYOKE – In partnership with the nonprofit CanCode Communities, Holyoke Community College is offering a free six-week beginner computer training course starting Sept. 30.

The real-time, instructor-led online classes will run Mondays and Wednesdays Sept. 30 to Nov. 6, from 5:30 to 8:30 p.m. Laptops and WiFi hotspots for internet access will be provided for students who need them.

The program is aimed at helping

individuals build essential computer skills for both personal and professional development. Participants will explore the Microsoft Office program, learn how to create resumes, manage calendars, and send email, and be introduced to the world of artificial intelligence.
