## IV. Committee Reports

- Audit and Finance Committee Trustee Epstein reported that we will have a strong finish in the market, which is good news for our funds.
- **By-Laws and Governance Committee** Trustee Vidal reminded the Board about the email regarding website information needed for each Trustee. This information will increase Trustees' visability. The half-day Board Retreat is scheduled for Tuesday, November 4, 2024 from 8 am to 12 pm here at HCC in The Learning Collaborative (Frost 265). At the Retreat, we will discuss the results from this year's Assessment Survey and Competency Survey. The focus will be to set goals for our committees for next year. Members of the Presidents' Cabinet will attend to help guide our efforts effectively.
- **Equity Committee** Interim Chair Smith reported that the Committee continues to meet with Elena from the Department of Higher Education to continue the planning for the
- Foundation Board Update Trustee Hebert asked Vice President Sbriscia to provide an update. Vice
  President Sbriscia reported that the Foundation Board is in their governance focus of recruitment. The

# President Timmons reported:

- He introduced Vice President Sbriscia, who noted a correction from last months Board Meeting
  presentation on Strategic Plan Metrics. A baseline figure for Metric 4.2 Charitable Contributions was
  adjusted to reflect the accurate baseline figure, which in turm made adjustments to year one and year
  two targets to be in alignment.
- On October 16, 2024, he attended an event at Holyoke Health Center where Senator Edward Markey presented Holyoke Health Center and Holyoke Community College with a \$1 million federal ward to support workforce iniatives; specifically the creation of a Healthcare Workforce Development Training Center
- On October 9, 2024, the College welcomed Lowell Purnam, the sole Trustee of the Lowell Observatory. He gave a presentation about the Arizona facility, the oldest private astronimical research institution in the US, which was founded in 1894.
- On Ocober 18, 2024, he attended the President's Roundtable event in Hartford, CT. This meeting concluded a four-day conference fro the Men of Color Student Leader Institute in which four of our

HCC students participated. He gave a shout out to Saul Cabin for leadership and coordination of this event.






# First Six to Nine Months: Design and Action





# First Six to Nine Months: Underway!




























