The Month of January is named after Janus, the Roman, two-faced god. One face always looked to the past while the other to the future, representing the end of a year and beginning of a new one.

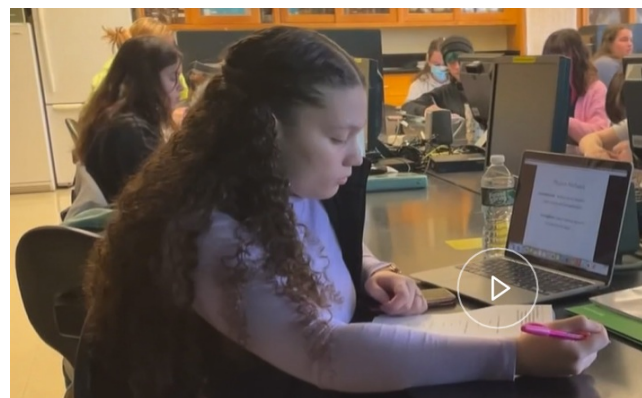

STUDENT SPOTLIGHT

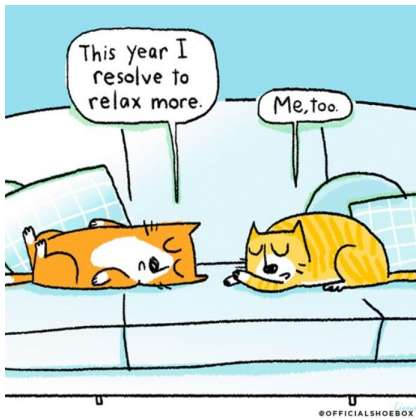
This Month our student Spotlight is Joni "Jay" George an English Major in her second year and was elected as representative for students in the Board of Trustees.

Student Emergency Fund

If you are struggling financially, the President's Student Emergency Fund can help! This fund assists HCC students who encounter unforeseen financial emergencies that would prevent them from continuing their education.

The COVID-19 pandemic has made these emergencies even more prevalent, but funding is available to help you overcome barriers related to housing, food, utilities, transportation and childcare. The application takes just a few minutes to complete and is reviewed within 48 hours. Students receive the support they need -- or are directed to other resources -- within a few days.
