Upon completion, apply to enter the construction field, a paid electrician apprenticeship program, or one of our clean energy technician programs.

To be eligible you must:

- + Be 18+ yrs of age and authorized to work in U.S.
- + Be able to start PT/FT work following training
- + Have a high school diploma or GED/HiSET
- + Participate in intake exams and interviews
- + Pass a sex offender background check (SORI)
